# Enhance productivity with continuity

## About this course

Take your productivity to the next level with Continuity features that make your Mac work seamlessly with your other Apple devices. Start with **Handoff** (*enhanced in macOS Tahoe*), a game changing feature that lets you start a task on one device and instantly pick it up on another.

Explore **Universal Control**, which allows you to use a single mouse and keyboard to control both your Mac and iPad, making multitasking easier than ever. You'll also discover **Universal Clipboard** (*enhanced in macOS Tahoe*), which lets you copy content on one device and paste it on another – whether it's text, images, or links.

Next, dive into **Continuity Camera** (*enhanced in Tahoe*), where you can use your iPhone or iPad to take photos, scan documents, or even add a sketch directly into your Mac. You will also learn how to use the powerful camera system of your iPhone as a webcam. Finally, learn how to use **Sidecar** to turn your iPad into a second display for your Mac, expanding your workspace and enhancing your productivity.

This session is all about making your Apple devices work together to save you time and increase efficiency, helping you get more done with less effort.
